

Proposed By-law Change

Parish by-laws may be changed at the parish Annual Meeting, as long as proposed changes are shared with the parish in writing at least four week before the meeting. Please review the proposal below, as we will be considering it at our Annual Meeting on Sunday, January 28th.

Rationale:

According to our current by-laws, in order for someone to be nominated for Vestry, they must be “either confirmed or received into the Episcopal faith.” This requirement is not what we currently practice, and it is more strict than the canons (church laws) of our Diocese and The Episcopal Church. The proposed by-law wording would line up with that of the diocesan and national canons and be more in keeping with our current practice of allowing all adult communicants in good standing to serve on the Vestry.

Trinity By-Law:

~~II.1 – The Vestry shall consist of lay members from the voting membership. (Vestry nominees shall be either confirmed or received into the Episcopal faith).—~~

The Vestry shall consist of adult communicants in good standing as defined by the canons of The Episcopal

Church, and shall be qualified voters of the congregations.
